

Expectations of Grand Line Officers

(Elected & Appointed)

- ❖ Attend 2017 Grand Commandery at the beginning of term. (See Section 5 E)
- ❖ Attend annual Family Day at MAHOVA
- ❖ Attend annual Religious Freedom Day activities at Fredericksburg, VA.
- ❖ Attend Official Visits of the Grand Commander at the Districts, If within reasonable distance.
- ❖ Attend at least one of the Knights Templar Schools of Instruction.
- ❖ Attend any conferrals of the Orders if within a reasonable distance.
- ❖ Participate in Grand Commandery Committee work.
- ❖ Attend Easter Sunrise at the George Washington National Masonic Memorial.
- ❖ Attend 2018 Grand Commandery at the end of term (Section 5 E).
- ❖ Complete the Knights Templar Correspondence Leadership Course.
- ❖ Visit each Commandery in your District at least once per quarter.
- ❖ Elected Grand Line Officers visit each District at least once during your sojourn from Grand Warder to Deputy Grand Commander.
- ❖ Attend annual Department Conference. (Dais Officers-Requirement, other Grand Line – Recommendation).
- ❖ Attend Quarterly meeting with Grand Line officers to discussed quarterly reports and other Grand Commandery Knights Templar of Virginia concerns.

Expectations of District Deputy Grand Commanders
(See Section 23. A.(2)(F))

- ❖ Attend 2017 Grand Commandery at the beginning of term as DDGC.
- ❖ Conduct Official Visit to each Commandery in District, including Inspection.
- ❖ Ensure that DDGC reports are filed within 10 days of the Official Visit with copies to Grand Commander, Deputy Grand Commander and Grand Recorder.
- ❖ Ensure that constituent Commandery Recorders file reports electronically and in a timely manner (within 15 days of change).
- ❖ To hold a fundraiser for our Bicentennial.
- ❖ To organize the Official Visit of the Grand Commander.
- ❖ Assist each incoming Commander in the District to ensure that he has developed a program for his year.
- ❖ To assist Commanders in District in having a planned assembly for Christmas, Good Friday, Easter and Ascension Day.
- ❖ To attend at least one Knights Templar Schools of Instruction.
- ❖ To assure that Commanders of constituent Commanderies appoint a York Rite Ambassador, Eye Foundation Chairman.
- ❖ To ensure that incoming Dais Officers eligibility at the time of their election and installation (Section 24 C (4)).
- ❖ Assist each Commander in the District in selecting a nominee for the Knight Templar Cross of Honor.
- ❖ Recommend a Sir Knight from your District for the Grice Award.
- ❖ To attend Leadership Course at Grand Annual Conclave.
- ❖ To complete Knights Templar Correspondence Leadership Course.
- ❖ To ensure that constituent Commandery, no later than December 1, recommends a Past Commander to serve as DDGC for the ensuing year (Section 24 C (7)).
- ❖ Attend annual Family Day at MHOVA.
- ❖ Attend annual Religious Freedom Day activities at Fredericksburg, VA.
- ❖ Attend Easter Sunrise Service at the George Washington National Masonic Memorial.
- ❖ Attend the Official Visit of Grand Commander at other Districts, if within a reasonable distance.
- ❖ Attend any conferrals of the Orders in your District.
- ❖ Make personal contact with all Sir Knights requesting a demit or in arrears on dues prior to granting of demit or suspension for non-payment of dues and attempt to convince them to remain a member in good standing.
- ❖ Attend annual Department Conference. (Recommendation)
- ❖ Attend 2018 Grand Commandery at the end of term as DDGC.

Expectations of District Instructors & Assistants

- ❖ Attend 2017 Grand Commandery at the beginning of term as District / Assistant Instructor.
- ❖ Attend each Commandery in your District and offer instruction to the Sir Knights in the Ritual and Tactics of the Commandery.
- ❖ Attend at least one of the Knights Templar School of Instruction.
- ❖ Develop a list of Sir Knights capable of conferring each part in each of the Orders. Share the list with Grand Line Officers, Grand Instructor General and the other District Instructors and Assistants.
- ❖ To complete the Knights Templar Correspondence Leadership Course.
- ❖ Become proficient in conferring at least one of the Orders in either short or long form.
- ❖ Attend 2018 Grand Commandery at end of term as District/Assistant Instructor.

Expectations of Constituent Commanders

- ❖ Attend 2017 Grand Commandery at the beginning of term. (See Section 24 (F)(3)).
- ❖ Develop a program for each monthly conclave for your year as Commander.
- ❖ Appoint a York Rite Ambassador, Holy Land Pilgrimage Chairman and Knights Templar Eye Foundation Chairman.
- ❖ Attend at least one Knights Templar School of Instruction.
- ❖ Have a program or activity to raise funds for the Knights Templar Eye Foundation or Knights Templar Holy Land Pilgrimage or Knights Templar Education Foundation.
- ❖ Have a planned program for Christmas, Good Friday, Easter and Ascension Day.
- ❖ Nominate a Past Commander from your Commandery to serve as DDGC. (See Section 24 C (7)).
- ❖ Nominate a member of your Commandery for the Knights Templar Cross of Honor.
- ❖ Nominate a minister for Holy Land Pilgrimage.
- ❖ Attend Leadership Course at Grand Commandery.
- ❖ Ensure that the By-Laws and Regulations of the Commandery are duly observed, as well as the Constitution, Laws, Ritual and Rules of the Grand Encampment and the Constitution, Laws and Regulations of the Grand Commandery.
